Ci poetry, like most Chinese literature, came about during the Tang Dynasty. However, ci lyric came into its fullest array later during the Song Dynasty, when the style was formatted and regularized. Ci lyrics are distinguished from other types of Chinese poetry by the fact that they are arranged to the tunes of traditional songs, known as cipai.

Chuci (lyrics of Chu) is a type of poetry that flourished in the Chu region during the Warring States period (403-227 b.c.e.). The poems were collected in the anthology Chuci zhangju (Commentary Edition of Chuci), edited by Wang Yi (fl. 114-119) of the Han dynasty. It contains nearly sixty poems, which can be divided into two groups.
